

## An Update for Our Patients, and Our Community March 18, 2020

Illinois Eye Center, along with the entire world, has been facing some increasingly difficult decisions over the past 2 weeks. How to balance the well-being of our patients, our staff, <u>and our community</u> has been an enormous challenge. After careful deliberation, the following temporary changes are being put in place as of **Thursday, March 19, and until further notice:** 

- 1. We will no longer be providing routine eye care Only urgent/emergent patient appointments will be seen. <u>An Illinois Eye Center staff member will contact you if your appointment is being rescheduled.</u>
- 2. Patients will only be seen by appointment any Walk-in Patient will be screened at the front door, and will be asked to call for a possible appointment.
- 3. EyeCareTODAY will be discontinued
- 4. Our Washington and Kewanee locations will be closed
- 5. Our Optical Department will be closed except for "curbside" or mail delivery of glasses and contacts.
- 6. Anyone meeting any of these criteria will <u>not</u> be allowed in the Peoria facility:
  - Has COVID-19 (coronavirus) symptoms, including fever, coughing, and any respiratory-related illness
  - > Has traveled outside of the United States within the last 14 days
  - Has been in close contact with a person in the last 14 days that has displayed COVID-19 symptoms
  - > Anyone accompanying a patient, except if needed for physical or mental assistance
  - > Anyone without an already scheduled patient appointment
  - > All external business partners and sales representatives
- 7. Visitors that accompany the patient for driving purposes, will be asked to remain outside/in their car until the patient completes their appointment.
- 8. We will be implementing appropriate social separation throughout our Waiting Rooms.

**PLEASE** continue to call Illinois Eye Center at **309-243-2400** if you are coughing, feverish, or otherwise feeling ill prior to your appointment with us - We will be happy to reschedule your appointment to a day when youS are feeling better.

The impact of COVID-19 is an evolving story, so please check back frequently for new updates.
